Attendance on courses is increasing and more and more adults are becoming aware of what is on offer within the County and how to access Training.

The Learning Process

One of the most commonly asked questions is what is the process for assigning Training Advisers?

Once a new adult has been given a provisional appointment the Appointments Secretary then informs the Local Training Manager. It is then the job of the Local Training Manager to contact the new learner letting them know who their Training Adviser is, they will also inform the Training Adviser and ideally let the GSL or DESC know too.

The only exception to this is in Districts where Training Advisers aren't assigned but regular Open Profiling/Validation sessions are held where learners can drop in and see any Training Adviser.

New Appointment Process Training

“Module 37: Advising on Adult Appointments”

We have now held three Module 37 Training Courses and have seen the majority of those who need to do the Training. We know that there are still a few people in the following roles plus new members to the Appointments Advisory Committee that need to do this module. The next Module 37 will be held on:

Booking for the above course can be done the normal way using the course application form.

This training will be free and is available for the following roles; District Commissioner (& Deputy), District Chairman (& Deputy), Appointments Chairman, Appointments Secretary, CRB Secretary, Appointment Advisory Committee Members, Local Training Managers and all Assistant County Commissioners.

Finally, vacancies in the team...

We have a number of key vacancies within the Adult Training Team;

Deputy County Training Manager (Specialist Training)

This role will involve being a member of the Training Leadership Group along with the CTM and DCTM's. The role involves researching, developing and implementing Specialist Training within the County and managing the provision and Trainers involved in it. Including First Aid, MMS, MENCAP, Risk Assessment, Cultural Awareness, Administrator Training, ADC Induction Training and more.....

Assistant County Training Manager (Local Delivery)

Working with the DCTM (Local Training Management) this role involves supporting the delivery of local modules across within Districts. Working directly with Local Training Managers supporting them with the delivery of Modules 1,3,4,5,6 and 7. Sharing good practices and running modules when needed.

Assistant County Training Manager (Trainer Training)

Working with the DCTM (Module Delivery) this role involves training the Trainers. Responsible for delivering Modules 27,28,29,30,31,32 and portfolio moderation. Prior knowledge of Training needed.
