Practical Skills – Module 18

On 20th March we will be running *Module 18 – Practical Skills*. The aim of this module is to gain and develop practical skills to assist with delivering the sectional programme.

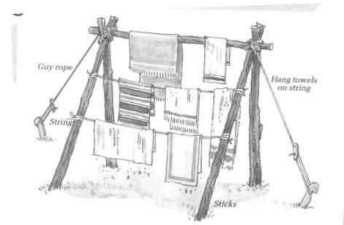
The day will include learning or improving a wide range of practical skills that are appropriate to the section adults are involved in and developing the ability to pass these skills on to our youth members.

The course also covers the validation of the module by asking adults to demonstrate the skills they have learnt.

The programme is tailored to the participants, however examples of skills that have been taught in the past include; Fires, Gadgets, Knife, Axe, Tilley Lamps, Wide Games, Knotting, Flags, Origami, Non Cook Cooking, Easy Pizzas, Sweet Pioneering, Pioneering, Crafts, Soap Carving, Mapping, Compass, Pond Dipping, Simple Science and Wet 'n' Wild!

The course will be held at Hargreaves Campsite, the HQ of Ilford East Scout District.

This means ensuring they complete *Getting Started* within 5 months and are working toward their Wood Badge (they have 3 years to achieve this!). The Local Training Manager and Training Advisers are there to support this process. If there are leaders in your Group who are without a Wood Badge and a Training Adviser, (or you aren't sure) then please contact your Local Training Manager. Training Advisers are appointed by the Local Training Manager as part of the Appointments Process.

Assessing Learning – Module 25

This is a required module for District Commissioners, Deputy District Commissioners, Group Scouts Leaders, Assistant Group Scout Leaders, District Explorer Scout Commissioners, Local Training Managers, Training Advisers and District Nights Away Advisers. There is no charge for this course providing adults hold one of the roles listed above. The course is also open to any adults interesting in being a Training Adviser plus all members of the GLNE County Team.

DCTM (Specialist Training)

I am delighted to announce that Amanda Harrison has been appointed Deputy County Training Manager for Specialist Training.
